- Case analysis,
Which should include, your method , why you choose it. Then what rubrics you have chosen and why?
Maximum number of rubrics 10, but aim for 5 or 6 well chosen rubrics.

- Then Reportorisation, Just the summary, the detailed bit goes in the back.
- Materia medica Differentiation and Remedy choice. Potency choice and why.
- Prescription. (even if no remedy - it is still a prescription).
- Then Prognosis.

Follow up. (three minimum).

- Reaction to remedy? How does it fit with your prognosis?
- New symptoms?
- Case Analysis, what are you going to next and why?
Are you going to give another remedy if so why? Even if it is the same, has it stopped acting? How do you know? If you are going to change remedy you need to be very clear why?
- Prescription
- Prognosis.
